National Education Day is celebrated to mark the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad. He served the country from 1947 to 1958 as the first Education Minister in Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru's cabinet. The day is usually observed by schools with various functions and programs.

Maulana Abul Kalam Azad was a reformer and freedom fighter. He was not merely a scholar but committed to building the nation through education. The Ministry of Human Resource Development announced on 11 September 2008, "The Ministry has decided to commemorate the birthday of this great son of India by recalling his contribution to the cause of education in India. November 11 every year, from 2008 onwards, will be

celebrated as the National Education Day, with declaring it as a holiday." All educational institutions in the country mark the day with seminars, symposia, essay-writing, elocution competitions, workshops and rallies with banner cards and slogans on the importance of literacy and the nation's commitment to all aspects of education.

The day is also seen as an occasion to remember Azad's contribution in laying the foundations of the education system in an independent India, and evaluating and improving the country's current performance in the field.

About the Event

In the event India's commitment to establish India as a global hub of education and to ensure high quality of education was reiterated through Study in India, Stay in India and Internationalization of Education.


Study in India, Stay in India is an extension of the Study in India program, a flagship project of the Government of India, launched in collaboration with the Ministry of Education, Ministry of External Affairs, Ministry of Home Affairs, and Ministry of Commerce and Industry in April 2018.

Study in India program objectives:

- To improve the soft power of India with focus on the neighboring countries and use it as a tool in diplomacy.
- To boost the number of inbound international students in India.
- To double India's market share of global education exports from less than 1 percent to 2 percent.
- Increase in contribution of international students in the form of direct spends, indirect spends, spillover effects.

- Improvement in overall quality of higher education.
- Increase in global ranking of India as an educational destination.
- To reduce the export Import imbalance in the number of international students.
- Growth of India's global market share of international students.
- India is cooperating and coordinating with the leading universities of the world. This
 has been incorporated in National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 by inviting top 100
 World Universities to set up campuses in India.
