









Student Grievance Committee

Agenda Item:

Allowing Sick Students to Enter the Institute Premises on their Vehicle

The meeting was called to order at 2.30pm by the Chairperson. The agenda item, which was a request from the student body to allow sick students to enter the institute premises on their vehicle, which is otherwise prohibited.

The Chairperson invited the Security Officer to present their views on the matter. The Security Officer explained that the current policy does not allow vehicles inside the institute premises to ensure the safety of the students and staff. They mentioned that this policy is strictly enforced, and there are no exceptions.

The Student Representatives presented the student's views on the matter. They explained that some students who are sick or have a disability find it difficult to walk to the institute premises from the parking area. They also mentioned that the current policy puts these students at risk, especially during extreme weather conditions.

The committee discussed the matter at length and considered various options. It was decided that sick students who have a medical certificate can enter the institute premises on their vehicle. The Security Officer would be informed of the policy change and would be responsible for ensuring compliance.



The committee also discussed the need for a designated parking area for sick students, which would be closer to the institute premises. It was decided that the administration would look into the feasibility of creating such a parking area.

The committee thanked the Student Representatives for bringing up the matter and assured them that their concerns would be addressed.

The meeting was adjourned at 3.30pm by the Chairperson.
