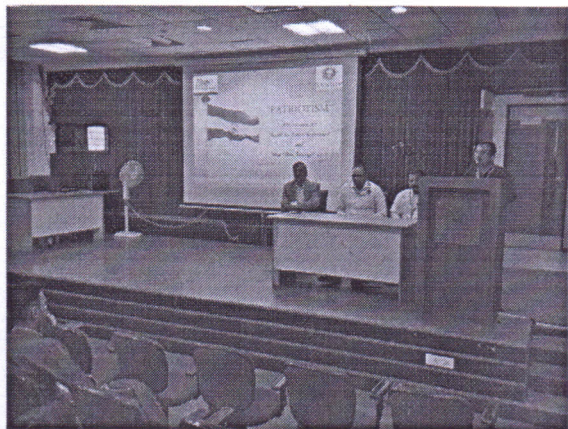
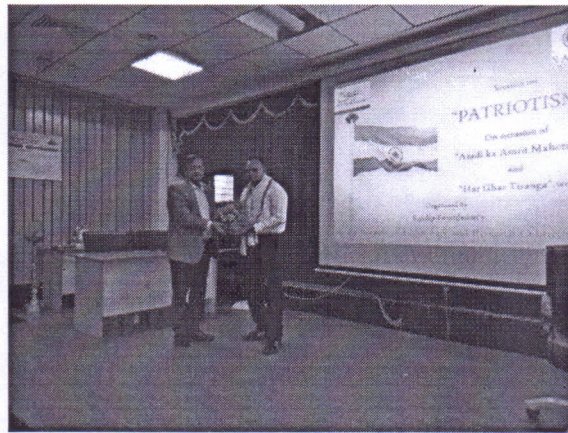
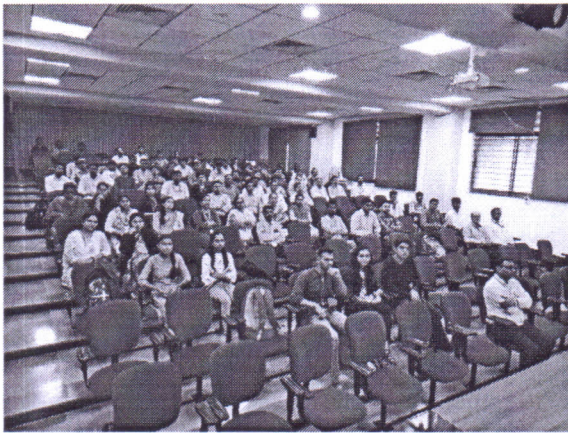
Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav
