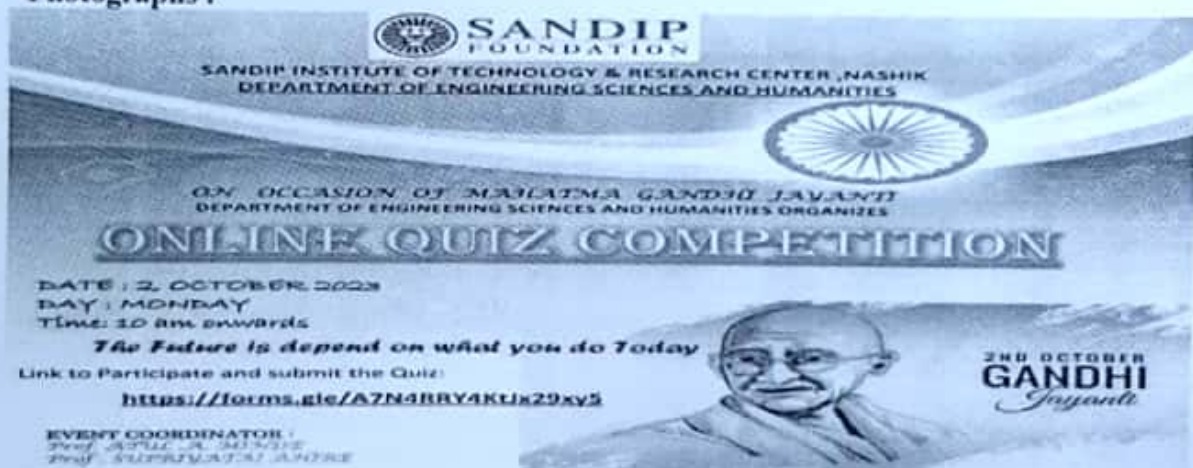
Activities:

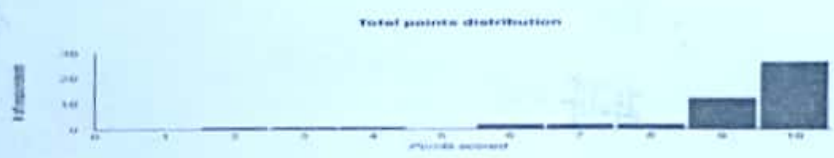

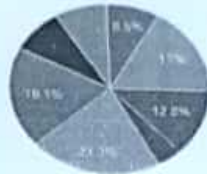
