- Academic Performance Improvement: With a more disciplined environment, students were able to focus better on their studies, leading to an overall


improvement in academic performance.

- Academic Performance Improvement: With a more disciplined environment, students were able to focus better on their studies, leading to an overall improvement in academic performance.


## Summary of Program:
