Outcomes :

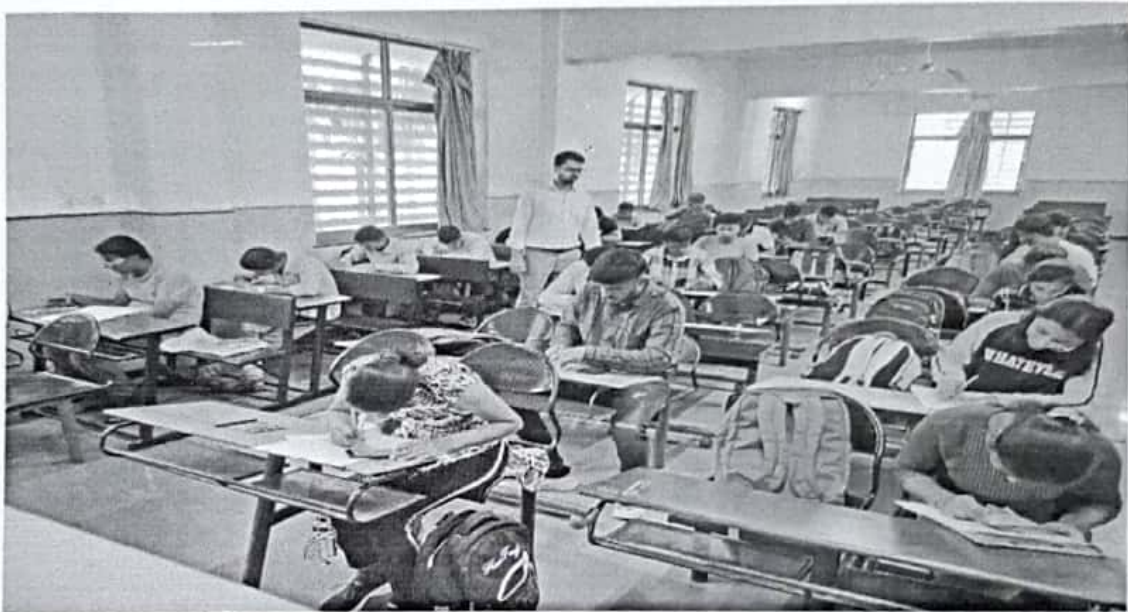
1. The competition provided a platform for students to showcase their artistic talents, revealing a remarkable array of creativity within the student community.

Summary of Program:

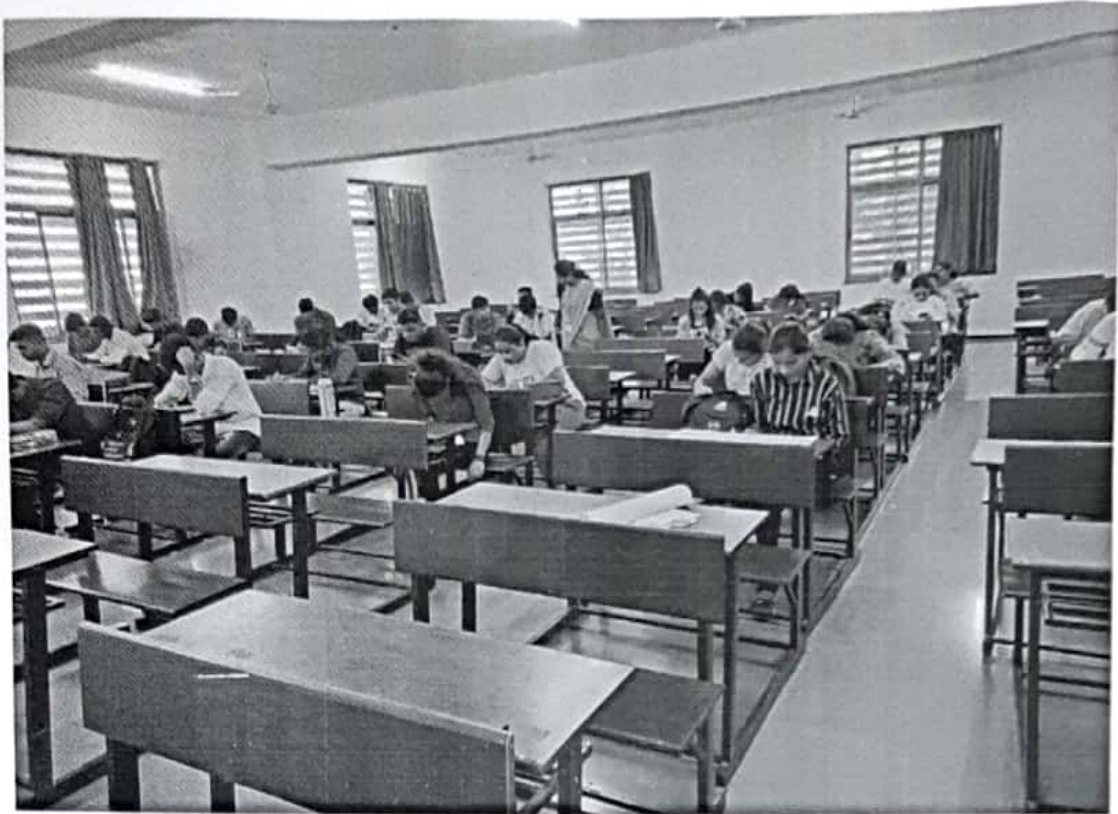
