

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ACADEMIC PROGRESSION

Student who has passed all courses of Semester-I and Semester-II of First Year Examinations (as per the rules of the Passing Standards) shall be promoted to Second Year of the program. A student who has passed all courses of Semester-III and Semester-IV of Second Year Examinations shall be promoted to Third Year of the program. A student who has passed all courses of Semester-V and Semester-VI of Third Year Examinations shall be promoted to Final Year of the program.

6.1 Progression of Students without SGPA in UG Program:

UG students who have not passed all courses of odd and even semesters in the academic year can register to succeeding years subject to the following conditions:

6.1.1 Student who earns more than 50% of the credits allotted in the studying academic year shall be allowed to keep turn (A.T.K.T.) for the next academic year irrespective of failures in any number of courses.

This criterion shall be applicable to the subsequent years also.

6.1.2 A student earning less than 50% of the credits allotted in the studying academic year even after SEE shall NOT be promoted to the next year.

6.1.3 A Student who has not earned minimum credits in the First Year of the program can't be promoted to the Third Year of the program from Second Year.

6.1.4 A Student who has not earned minimum credits in the Second Year of the program can't be promoted to the Final Year of the program from Third Year.

6.2 Progression of Students in PG Program:

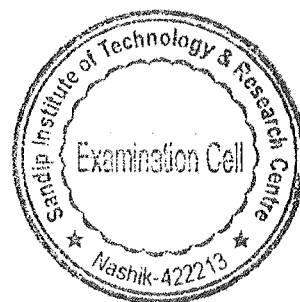
PG programs being a mix of theory courses and major project work, the academic progression is governed in the following manner.

6.2.1 Student can register for the second semester without minimum credit requirement in the First Semester.

6.2.2 For registration to Third semester of PG program, all credits in the First Semester shall be earned.

6.2.3 Student can register for the third semester without minimum credit requirement in the second semester.

6.2.4 For registration to fourth semester of PG program, all credits till second semester shall be earned.



6.3 Academic Break:

6.3.1 Withdrawal on medical grounds / other very exceptional reasons may be permitted by Institute, however it should not exceed validity of program.

6.3.2 Student can take re-admission in different years as long as total period of the program does not exceed the validity period of that program. Admission to the subsequent years is subject to maximum duration permissible for completion of the program (in years).


6.4 Progression for Honors/Minors Program:

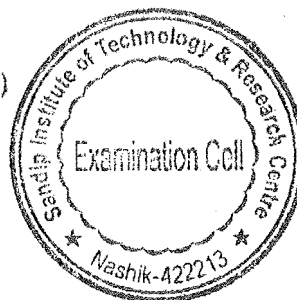
Student scoring yearly based SGPA greater than or equal to 7.75 (i.e. First Class with Distinction) after the completion of fourth semester will be eligible to take the Honors program under their Major Program of their discipline. The students are allowed to take Honors program of other disciplines which will be treated as Minor Program for them. The rules for assessment will be same for both Honors & Minor Programs.


Student with consistent SGPA above 9 in each semester will be allowed to take two distinct Minor Degree programs simultaneously.

The student taking Honors/Minor Program will have to pass the courses under that program in the same academic year of learning. The students failing to pass the courses within the same academic year will get automatically disqualified from Honors/Minor degree program.

The performance in Honors/Minor Program shall not be considered neither in the evaluation of CGPA of Major Program nor in the decision of progression in the Major discipline of learning.
