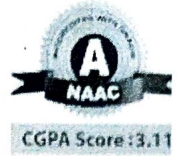

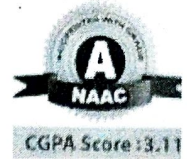

- To discuss upcoming events, school policies, and student welfare initiatives.

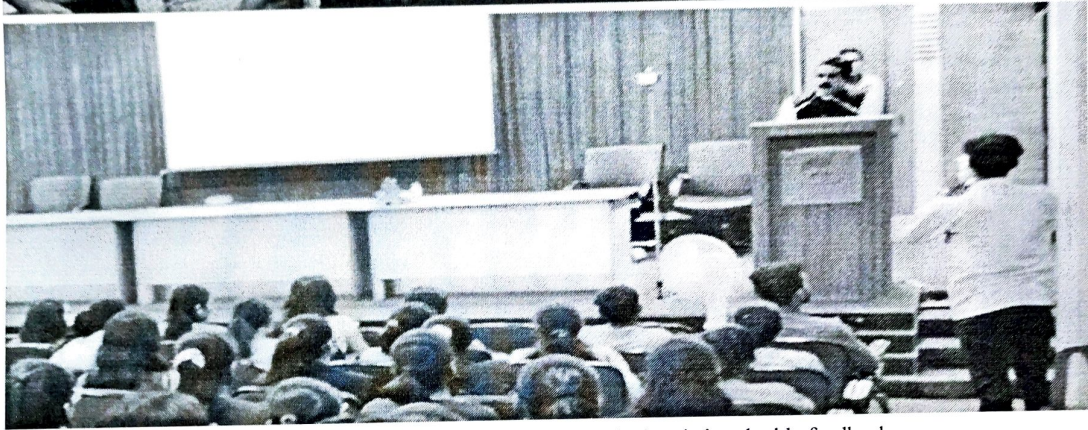
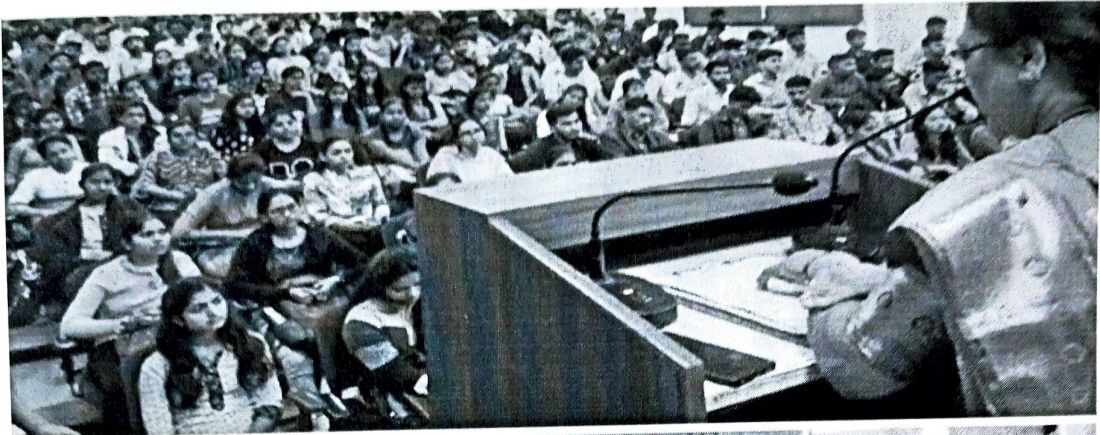
Outcomes:
